State Wildlife Action Plan (SWAP)



State Wildlife Grant (SWG) Funds:

Support actions that support Species of Greatest Conservation Need (SGCN)

Goal:

Keep species **OFF** the endangered list!

Timeline...

March 2025: Draft due to ADFG Commissioner

May/June 2025: Public review

October 2025: SWAP revision due!

2025 SGCN List (370 taxa)

Birds (194 spp.):

- 1. Threatened or Endangered
- 2. Alaska Species Ranking System (ASRS: ranks I-IV)
- 3. Alaska Shorebird Plan (Table 4)
- 4. Alaska Landbird Plan (Tables 2 & 3)
